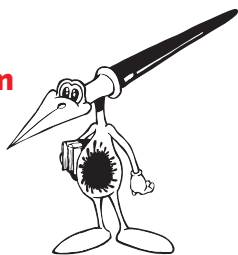


APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS DEADLINE: JUNE 18!!

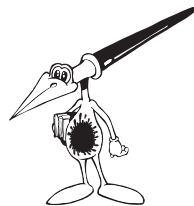

Writing samples **MUST** be word-processed, 12-point font, **double-spaced**. **DO NOT submit originals**; samples will not be returned. Please submit only **ONE** writing sample.

Letter of Reference

Referees are asked to indicate their knowledge of the applicant's suitability for the YouthWrite program and comment on the applicant's special strengths. (Letters from relatives are NOT acceptable.)

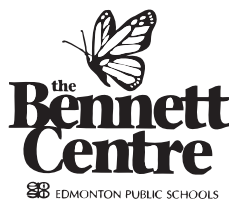

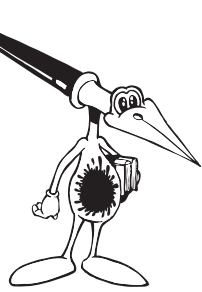
